



### **Position: Fisheries Internship Position**

The Native Village of Napaimute has a Seasonal Full Time position for Partners in Fisheries Monitoring Program Fisheries Intern position. The position will be; seasonal, full time, for a maximum of three months, 40 hours a week; the pay is \$18.75/hr.

**Duties:** Major duties and responsibilities of this position include:

- Assist Staff with implementing fisheries and environmental monitoring projects;
- Assist staff at developing and delivering outreach messages related to fisheries activity and conservation;
- Assist Staff with Youth Outreach projects;
- Participation in various advisory group meetings;
- Assist Staff with data collection and preparing draft reports;
- Assist Staff with logistics for all aspects of the program;
- Assist Staff with light administrative task.

**Additional Information:** This position will be seasonally, approximately June - October located in the Middle Kuskokwim River Regions, but based out of Aniak. It combines fisheries research and monitoring with outreach, education, capacity building and cooperation to ensure the sustainability of Alaska Native subsistence opportunities. The Intern will assist Staff with a variety of fisheries issues, stock assessments, and environmental monitoring projects. Many of the projects are in remote locations and will involve travel by boat for extended periods of time and spending up to two weeks in field camps. This position will work directly under the supervision and guidance of the Napaimute Environmental Director/ Partners Biologist.

**Qualifications:** Candidates must have at a minimum: A High School diploma or GED. Quality candidates are those that can demonstrate strong skills in communications (written, oral, social media), and have a fundamental knowledge of conservation principles and the local culture.
